The rules will be used for tournaments, sit & go's and cashgames.

4-3 DISCREPANCIES AND RULINGS.

In certain circumstances during cashgames can floor people use camera images to come back on a previous incorrect pot, even if a next hand has already started.

5-3 ETHICAL PLAY

Every player that is involved in collusion will receive a penalty that can go up to disqualification or even exclusion from the casino

6-3 ONE PLAYER TO A HAND

Not applicable after the hand

7-1-k POKER ETIQUETTE

Not applicable in cashgames

8 DEAL MAKING

Each deal that distributes all the rest of the prize money will make immediately an end to the tournament or sit&go

9 PENALTIES AND DISQUALIFICATIONS

Penalty by round.

In cashgames a financial penalty (fine) up to 20€ can be given by a floor person, the player then has the choice to pay or leave the table.

10 OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

French, Dutch (Flemish) and English

11 COMMUNICATION DEVICES

Not applicable, communication instruments are not allowed on the table, a sanction can be given by a floor person in function of the circumstances.

12-5 ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Not applicable

14-5 REGISTRATION

Not applicable

15-2 ALTERNATE PLAYERS

An alternate player can be penalized with a reduced starting stack

18 REBUYS

Remark: You have to have chips in front of you in order to take an add-on.

25-3, 25-4 BALANCING TABLES

Not applicable

26-2 CARDS

Not applicable, except on tables with automatic shufflers.

28-2 DEALING

Except in cashgames

30-1 FOULED DECK

The hand will be finished, only thereafter the deck will be changed (the floor person remains the right to cancel the hand when he think it is necessary).

33-3 RABBIT HUNTING

Except in cashgames

37-2 COLOR-UP

Also chips of other denominations can be used at the choice of the floor person

40 PLACEMENT OF DEALER BUTTON

The button will always begin in seat 1, except in cashgames

44-2 BLINDS

Except in cashgames

49-2 FINAL TABLE

No draw, the button begins in seat 1

50-3 BETTING LINE

Cards released in a forward motion, inside and over the "betting line" face down will be considered a "folded/mucked hand," , also considered as a folded hand will be hands that don't cross the line but are clearly released in a forward motion with the intention to fold

51-4 SAFE ZONE

Except after agreement of the player (even tacit)

53-5 CHECKING

Not applicable

58-1 POT SIZE

Except in cashgames

59-3 ALL-IN

Except in cashgames

61-2 a RAISE REQUIREMENTS

The minimum raise is the double of the last bet, not the raise

67-4 a EXPOSING CARDS

Except in cashgames

69-2 KAARTEN OPEN

Not applicable in cashgames

75-5 POT AWARDING

In certain circumstances during cashgames can floor people use camera images to come back on a previous incorrect pot, even if a next hand has already started.

78-3 b DEAD HAND

When the Floor person decides that he did this intentionally

78-3 i DEAD HAND

Not applicable

80-3 BOARD ERRORS

Not applicable, the hand will be finished unless the floor person thinks it is necessary to cancel the hand
